Payment Terms

Cancellation Policy

- Session fees will be charged in full if an appointment is canceled without 24 hours' notice.

General Policies

- Pet parents must consult with a licensed veterinarian regarding the hydrotherapy given by DOGGIEVILLE and provide any relevant medical information, recommendations, and limitations acknowledged by the veterinarian.
- A general health check is carried out before each hydrotherapy treatment. This does not replace a thorough examination from your veterinarian. If the therapist thinks that your dog is unwell, treatment will not commence. You will not be charged for this session.
- All dogs must be evaluated through an Initial Rehab/Hydro or Fitness Consultation to make sure that they are safe to swim before they use the pool.
- Pet parents are requested not to feed their pups at least two hours before the appointment. Allow a minimum of one hour after therapy before feeding.
- Pet parents should ensure their dog has relieved themselves outside before swimming. If your dog defecates in the pool, please inform a staff member immediately so that it can be cleaned properly. In the case of diarrhea, we reserve the right to charge you two hundred dollars (\$200) to your account as the pool needs to be shut down for cleaning and disinfection.
- Prior to using our pool, all dogs must be relatively clean; have well-trimmed nails, and be brushed, especially if they are shedding. If required, a self-serve shower station is available. Also, our groomers at Chloé's Spaw can do nail trims on a walk-in basis or bathing by appointment.
- If your dog has diarrhea, open wounds, infectious or contagious conditions such as ear, eye, or skin infections your therapy/fitness session would need to be postponed. This is both for your dog's health and the health of other dogs. Please ensure that you should cancel your appointments (with as much notice as possible) should your dog experience any of these conditions. If we do not receive notice at least 24 hours in advance, session fees will be charged in full.
- Pet parents are responsible for the safety and well-being of their dogs and themselves while in and out of the pool. The DV Paw Crew is on hand to answer questions and provide guidance as required.
- At the end of your dog's swim, dogs need to be properly dried to prevent illness, further deterioration of the affected area (e.g. arthritis) and to prevent muscles from seizing up. You can use DV Doggie towels and the self-serve dry station. We suggest bringing towels for your car and/or a dog jacket during colder months.
- Your dog may behave differently after a therapy session, please be aware of this particular.
- Pet parents are required to notify us if during treatment, the dog's condition or injury worsens, or if the vet advises that the treatment be stopped or suspended.
- Owners are requested to wear non-slip footwear and waterproof clothing for health and safety reasons.
- If you are late for your session, it may be shortened due to the next scheduled appointment and you will be charged in full for the session.

General Terms

- All dogs must be kept under control and on a leash while on the premises and in the surrounding areas.
- Pet parents are responsible for their dog(s) while in the facility.
- Pet parents are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the premises and in the surrounding areas.
- Puppies under four months of age are not allowed.
- Children must always be supervised.
